The Institute of Real Estate Management (IREM) is the sponsor of the John Cotton Memorial Scholarship which is awarded through Chapter No. 18 in San Diego. This program recognizes qualified individuals who express an interest in earning an IREM credential.

The San Diego Chapter was officially chartered by IREM National in December 1947. Dating from the 1930s, several San Diegans joined IREM and traveled monthly to attend the Los Angeles Chapter dinner meetings. These early CPM® members were: O.W. Cotton, Ewart W. Goodwin, Lloyd Baldrige, **John Cotton**, Julius Kemmer, William W. Murray, and John D. Thompson, Jr.

These early IREM pioneers helped shape and define Property Management in a time when the concept of Property Management was considered a separate industry and not accepted as a Real Estate practice. The John Cotton Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 1988 with the goal of awarding educational funds to individuals interested in pursuing the industry of Property Management.
